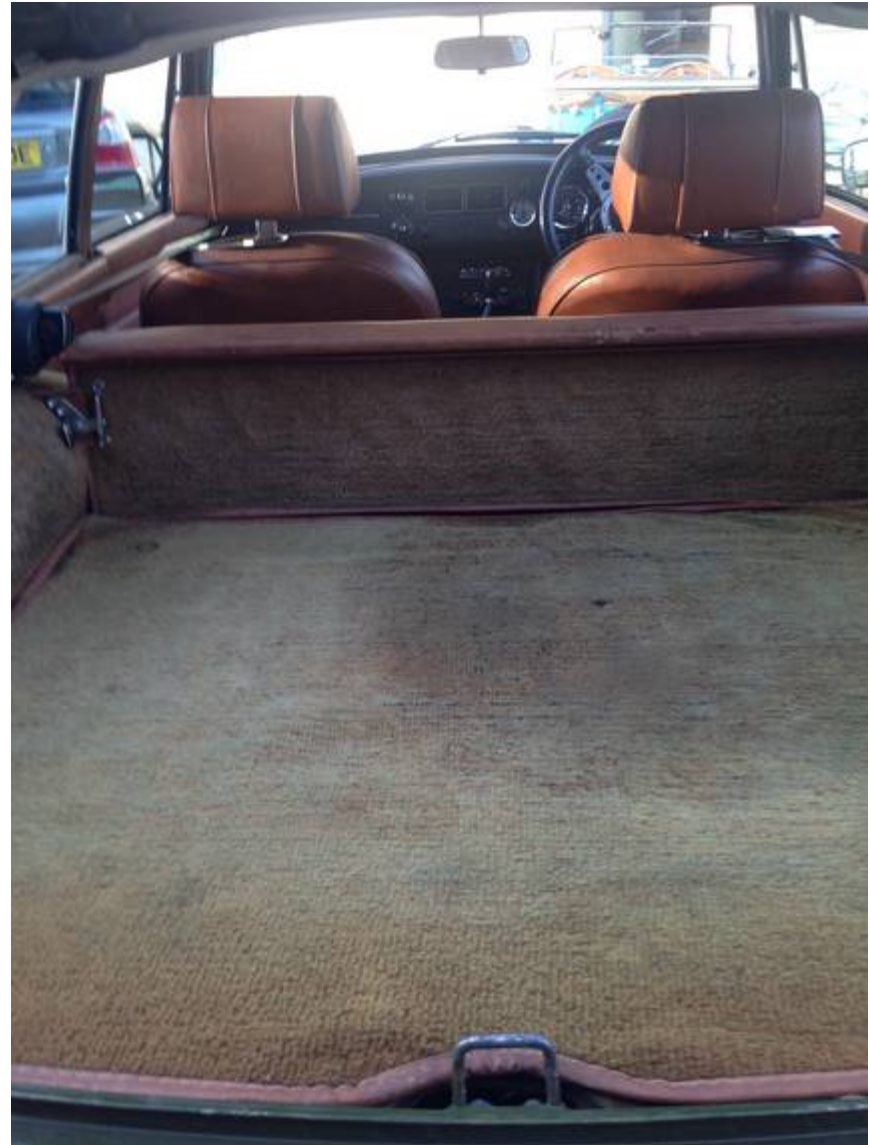
Private sale at auction - chrome bumper Factory MGBGT V8 in Tundra

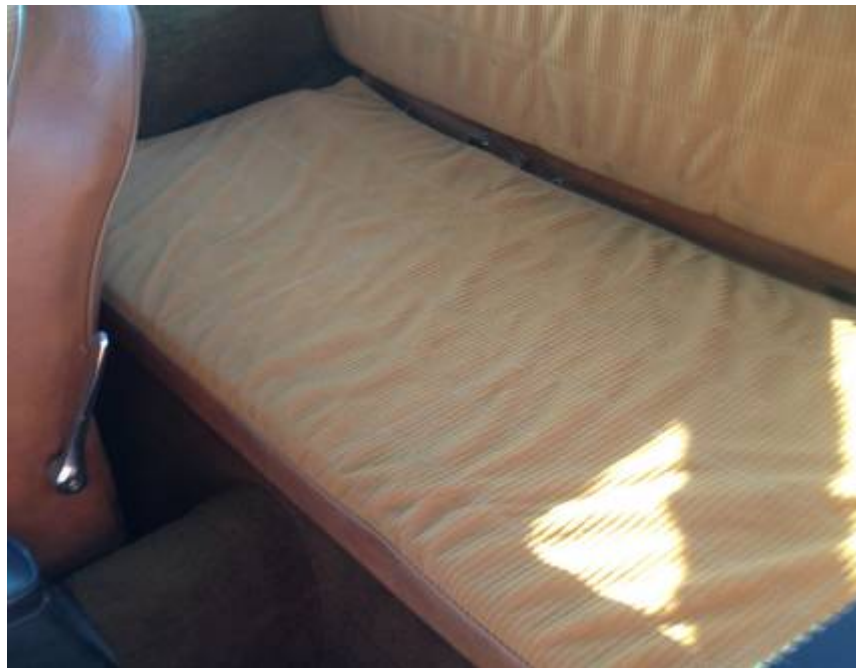
