Electrical modifications

1. Upgrading the headlight reflectors and fitting halogen bulbs.
2. Adding an inline fuse to the overdrive circuit.
3. Fitting a lights-on alarm.
4. Fitting a Revotec cooling fan upgrade kit.
5. Fitting a 12v battery improvement.
6. Replacing the "top hat" battery terminals with clamp type.
7. Fitting a cooling fans override switch.
8. Fitting central locking.
9. Fitting a simple ant-theft device (coil cut-out).
10. Installing cruise control.

Steering and suspension modifications

11. Installing a Hoyle IRS front suspension upgrade.
12. Installing a Hoyle IRS and disc brake upgrade.
13. Fitting parabolic rear springs.
14. Fitting a castor reduction kit (Brown & Gammons or Frontline).
15. Fitting uprated suspension bushes.
16. Fitting power steering (hydraulic, electro-hydraulic or EPAS).
17. Fitting replacement telescopic shock absorbers.
18. Fitting a steering rack mount strengthening kit (Brown & Gammons).
19. Replacing tyres for improved ride and handling.
20. Adjusting standard tyre pressures for improved ride and handling.

Braking modifications

21. Installing a low brake fluid sensor (TE Electronics)

22. Changing the brake servo as a precaution to avoid a failure
23. Changing brake fluid from mineral to silicon

Engine and cooling modifications

24. Fitting alternative carburettor needles
25. Installing a Petronix or Lumination electronic ignition upgrade.
26. Installing an upgraded radiator.
27. Fitting a brass or stainless steel replacement coolant filler plug.
28. Removing a section of rubber bonnet seal next to the windscreen to allow engine heat to escape

Transmission modifications

29. Installing a 5-speed gearbox
30. Restoring the differential using a "bronze" shim kit
31. Restoring overdrive on third gear.

Interior modifications

32. Improving the standard seat cushions.
33. Upgrading the original cloth covered seats to leather.
34. Installing an air-conditioning system.
35. Fitting a chrome or stainless steel air intake mesh.
36. Fitting an uprated heater matrix and fan.
37. Fitting a replacement timber dashboard.
38. Fitting an aftermarket sun roof (Webasto or equivalent).
39. Fitting a front spoiler or air dam.
40. Fitting high security locks to the doors and tailgate.
