THE MG CAR CLUB is excited to announce that a brand new **MG6** will be on display in Abingdon's market square on Sunday 18 July, when MG Motor UK's latest model returns to the marques' spiritual home for the first time.

The MG6 will be on hand to help celebrate the achievements of enthusiasts from the MGCC's Gold Coast centre, who are embarking on the final leg of a mammoth journey which saw them leave China over three months ago.

The 'MG6' is the first all-new MG for 15 years and has registered impressive sales figures in China. Powered by a 1.8ltr 4cyl turbo engine, the saloon car has received favourable feedback from the motoring press.

Huge excitement surrounds the vehicle which will go on general sale towards the back end of 2010. It's appearance at Abingdon on Sunday (18 July) will be only it's third at a public event and local people are urged to come and see the car.

The MG6 is designed and engineered in Britain and will be built by MG Motor UK at its factory in Birmingham.

Abingdon will enjoy a truly international flavour when the town welcomes a broad spectrum of MG cars on Sunday (18 July), as a group of Australian MG Car Club members descend on Oxfordshire.

All driving classic examples of Abingdon's most famous export, the owners began their adventure at MG's Chinese factory and are scheduled to conclude their journey at MG Motor UK's Birmingham site on Monday 19 July.
