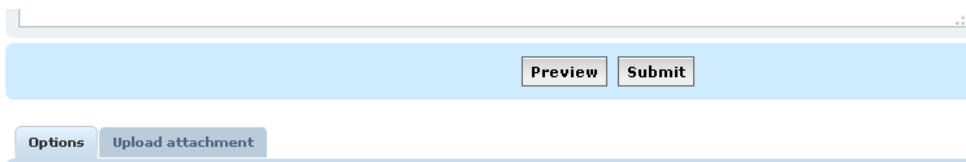


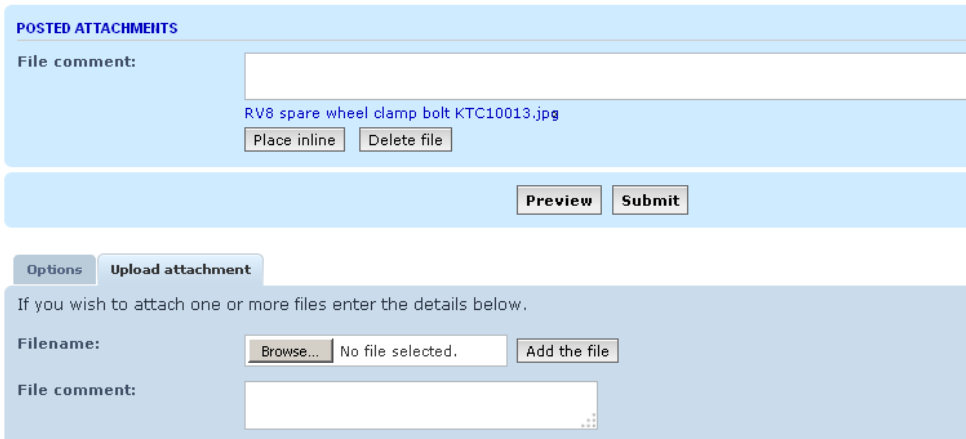
## V8 Bulletin Board – attaching an image file (photo) or other file

If you wish to attach an image file (photo) or other file (for example a PDF document) to a posting on the V8BB, the “**attachment**” procedure is as follows:

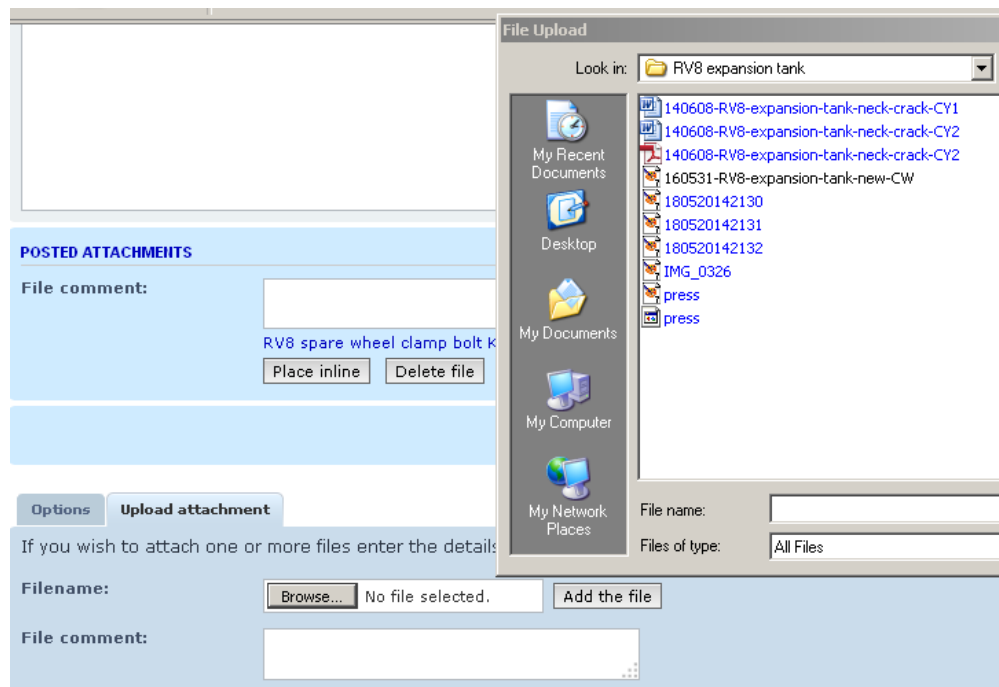
**Scroll to below the Preview & Submit buttons** at the bottom of the text panel where you will see two buttons – options and then **Upload Attachment**.



### Select Upload Attachment



Click **Browse** and then find the folder on your PC or other device with the file you wish to attach to your posting.



**Select the file** as the attachment.

Click “**Add the file**”

It will then appear below the posting as an image (if it’s an image file/photo) or a file (for example a PDF document)



If you try to insert a photo or document in the text of your posting, just use the link as it appears in your browser – for example <http://www.v8register.net/more.htm> **Do not generate a link with prefixes like [attachment=0]filename[/attachment] as this will not work in V8BB postings.** Either use the correct website link in the text of the posting **or** the simple and effective attachment procedure described above.

You **can attach several image files/photos or other files** (for example a PDF document) **by repeating the "attachment" routine.** Using the "Edit" function you can return to your posting and edit the text in your posting and/or add an additional file or files using the "attachment" routine.
