### V8 Bulletin Board – Terms & Conditions

A V8 Bulletin Board (“V8BB”) Registered User Account is only available to current members of the MG Car Club or an affiliated club who have also registered an MGV8 with the V8 Register.

By accessing the V8BB owned, managed and moderated by the V8 Register – MG Car Club (“V8 Register”) and available online at <http://www.v8bb.co.uk> you (the applicant for a Registered User account with the V8BB) hereby unconditionally agree to observe and fully comply with these V8BB Terms & Conditions, which shall include the V8BB Rules, as they may be updated and/or amended from time to time, and be legally bound by them. If you do not agree to be legally bound by all of the following V8BB Terms & Conditions including the V8 Rules, then please do not access and/or use the V8BB or any related services or facilities. We may change these terms at any time and will use our reasonable efforts to inform you of such changes by way of a notice or an announcement on the V8BB website, so it would be prudent for you to review the V8BB Announcements & Notices section of the V8BB website regularly as your continued use of V8BB, after any changes we may make, shall be your confirmation that you agree to be legally bound by those amended V8BB Terms and Conditions and V8BB Rules.

You agree not to post any obscene, hateful, abusive, threatening, vulgar, defamatory, slanderous, sexually-orientated, any material that might be considered libellous or any other material that may violate any laws in England, other parts of the UK, in your country, the country where V8BB is hosted or any International Law. Should you do so it may lead to your being immediately and permanently banned, with notification to your Internet Service Provider if deemed necessary by the V8 Register. The IP addresses of all posts on the V8BB are recorded to aid our enforcing these conditions. You agree that V8 Register has the right to remove, edit, move or close any topic at any time should the V8 Register see fit. As a user you agree to any personal information you have entered being stored in a database. While this information will not be disclosed to any third party without your consent, neither V8 Register, its officers, the MG Car Club nor phpBB shall be held responsible for any hacking attempt that may lead to the data being compromised.

Our V8BB or forum is powered by phpBB (hereinafter “phpBB software”, “[www.phpbb.com](http://www.phpbb.com)”, “phpBB Group”, “phpBB Teams”) which is a bulletin board solution released under the “General Public License” (hereinafter “GPL”) and can be downloaded from [www.phpbb.com](http://www.phpbb.com). The phpBB software only facilitates internet based discussions, the phpBB Group are not responsible for what the V8 Register may allow and/or disallow as permissible content and/or conduct on or in connection with the V8BB. This agreement shall be governed and construed by English law.

### V8 Bulletin Board - Rules

- Using the V8BB is deemed to be an acceptance of the Terms & Conditions and of the Rules. Failure to follow them may lead to the deletion of postings and temporary or permanent loss of V8BB user privileges.
- Reading and searching on the V8BB is open to all, but posting is restricted to Registered Users. Others may apply for limited registration which permits up to three postings. Registered users must not permit others to use their registration and V8BB user privileges.
- Registration must be in your real name, pseudonyms and nicknames are not permitted, and your current valid email address must be provided.
- Before posting please check to see if the topic has already been covered, if it has please make your contribution on the original thread, or provide a link to it.
- Use a descriptive title as the subject of new Topic to enable others to find what they want to read.
- To ensure clear understanding, please post in standard punctuated English, do not use text speak and do not post all in capital letters or as a lower case text stream for either the subject or body of the post. Lower case user names are not accepted.
- To ensure an open, welcoming atmosphere please be respectful to other users, criticise ideas if necessary, but not people. Do not use language which is vulgar, defamatory, inaccurate, harassing, hateful, sexually oriented or which may violate any law. You remain personally responsible and legally liable for the content of your messages.
- Respect the privacy of others and do not post phone numbers, street addresses, email addresses or photographs of others without their permission.
- The main website run by the V8 Register has facilities for advertising spares parts, cars or other items so please do not post advertisements of any kind on the V8BB.
- Please do not use the V8BB as a chatroom or post off-topic comments, in particular political or religious comments.
- If any individual user or group of users is seen to be dominating the V8BB in terms of frequency of posting, content or style, the moderators will take action against them.
- If information is not from your own experience please cite the source or provide a link. Do not post copyright material, if it is on another site link to it rather than cut and paste it in any post made on the V8BB.
- The V8BB is moderated, and any one moderator may take action. An appeal against a moderator’s action may be made to the V8BB Administrator who will review it. Any unresolved issue may be referred to the V8 Register committee.
- The material on the V8BB is the copyright of the V8 Register and must not be used elsewhere without the prior written permission of the V8 Register.
