

V8 Garden Visit to Lower Hall in Worfield on Sunday 17th August 2014



Clive Wheatley is arranging a private visit to the beautiful gardens at Lower Hall, a privately owned 16th century timber house in the centre of Worfield, a village 3½ half miles east of Bridgnorth in Shropshire. The gardens cover 4 acres with a walled garden with roses, clematis and mixed borders, and a water garden with a pool and rock garden. A woodland area has rare mature trees including magnolias, paper bark and Japanese maples. The River Worfe which gives the village its name meanders through the garden.
