

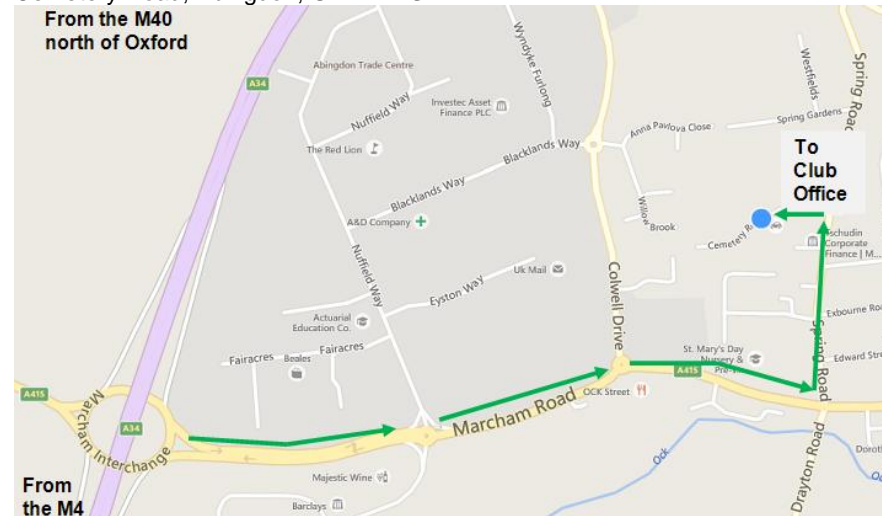
V8 Anniversary Day – Saturday 21st May 2016

From the M4, leave at Junction 13 and head for the A34 signposted for Oxford and then head north over the eastern end of the Berkshire Downs. At the Marcham interchange take the slip road and turn right round the roundabout into Abingdon and follow the map above.
