

Redbourn Classics Motor Show is held in Hertfordshire on Redbourn Common on Saturday 16th September 2017, noon until 6pm

The event is open to cars, bikes, commercial vehicles, tractors and steam engines. We hope it may become an annual event. Several members of our committee go to the nearby Harpenden Classic Car event every July (which a really good day out and raises a large amount for charity each year) and we decided that 2017 is the year to set up a similar event on Redbourn Common which is very attractive with large flat grassy areas with easy access from the M1 (junction 9) and M25 motorways, very close to St Albans. All proceeds from vehicle entries and bucket collection will go to local charities.

The local Parish Council have given their permission to use beautiful Redbourn Common, postcode AL3 7BU with the vehicles in the centre, stalls around the perimeter and lots of space for bouncy castles, tug of war or other activities too. There will be hot food stalls, a licenced bar and prizes for best vintage outfit and best vehicle.

A flyer about Redbourn Classics Motor Show is to spread an awareness of the event among local classic vehicle owners. The organisers currently have permission for at least 100 classic vehicles but expect this to increase over the coming months. Already half the tickets have been sold.
