

UK classic car ownership capital revealed by Classic Car Weekly

Classic Car Weekly highlighted the top ten locations for classic cars in the UK with the top three in the Midlands.

An analysis of the location data in the V8 Database shows the top regional locations are the South East, East Anglia and the South West which together have 54% of the MGV8s in the UK. Members in the East and West Midlands have together 15% of the MGV8s.
