### Visit to the Forge Mill Needle Museum & Bordesley Abbey Visitor Centre on Wednesday 12th June 2019

Around 90% of the world's demand for needles and pins were produced here in the 19th Century. Forge mill is situated next to Bordesley Abbey, site of former 12th century Cistercian Abbey. This will be an interesting visit. Find out how they managed to make as many as 3 million needles a week in one mill with water as the main source of power.

### Parking

Good car parking on site and easy access from M42 J2 via A441, which is recommended to avoiding getting lost in Redditch.

### Cost

Cost for the welcome drink and two tours will be £10.50 plus £12.00 for lunch if desired but which must be booked in advance. We will need firm bookings to ensure guides are in place and lunch is provided. Payment on entry.
