



Larger capacity for a replacement fuel tank

Roger Powell is undertaking a major restoration of an MGBGT V8 and posted a brief note on the V8 Register Facebook website highlighting "Moss offer a 60 litre

"long range" **Touring fuel tank** for less than the price of a standard one. With a V8 3.5 litre to feed it seemed like a good investment."

Torbjörn Andreasson in Sweden responded saying "installed the same last winter and found it makes a difference when touring."

The **extra capacity "Touring" fuel tank** was developed by Moss Motors for MGB owners looking for a few extra miles between fill-ups. Moss say "this tank has a 13.3 gallon capacity and is compatible with the standard tank sender. The Touring tank features include internal baffling for better fuel control, bottom mount low-profile drain plug for easy service/cleaning,

manufactured from Terne Coated Steel to help prevent internal corrosion with exterior black paint for OE style looks." With increasing ethanol levels in motor fuel the absorption of moisture during a lay-up can increase the risk of corrosion in the tank so the coating is welcome. All for £96.

The additional capacity of 1.3 gallons (10.8%) could produce a useful additional range of between 35 and 39 miles (27/30 mpg).
