The run is approximately 21 miles and is scheduled to take approx 6 hours and will start at **0930 hrs** from a field <u>half a mile up the road</u> from the Chequers Pub in Fingest Oxon. RG9 6QD. (the actual field will be signed). The run this year will be a figure of 8, with lunch in the same field as we start and finish from. Toilets and sanitising stations will be provided. We plan to be at the end at approx. 1630hrs. Trailer and vehicle access will be provided but the security of any vehicles left will be the owner's responsibility.

We do use public roads so please ensure that your machine is in a roadworthy condition, uses legal fuel and has the relevant Road Traffic Act Insurance, including third party public liability indemnity. (Details of Insurance are needed on the entry form)

We ask that passengers are only permitted on tractors with factory fitted seats or in approved passenger carrying roadworthy trailers.

This year's dress up theme is 'Independence Day' for you, any passengers and your tractor/trailer - there will be a prize for the best turnout – make it colourful!

Any family friends not taking part in the actual run are welcome to join us over lunch but in order to support "track & trace" name and address details must be provided before entering the site. The field we are using is kindly provided by James Jackson Esq. Hanger Farm. We will be providing a good discounted lunch on the day and all profits from this lunch will go to our Charity.
