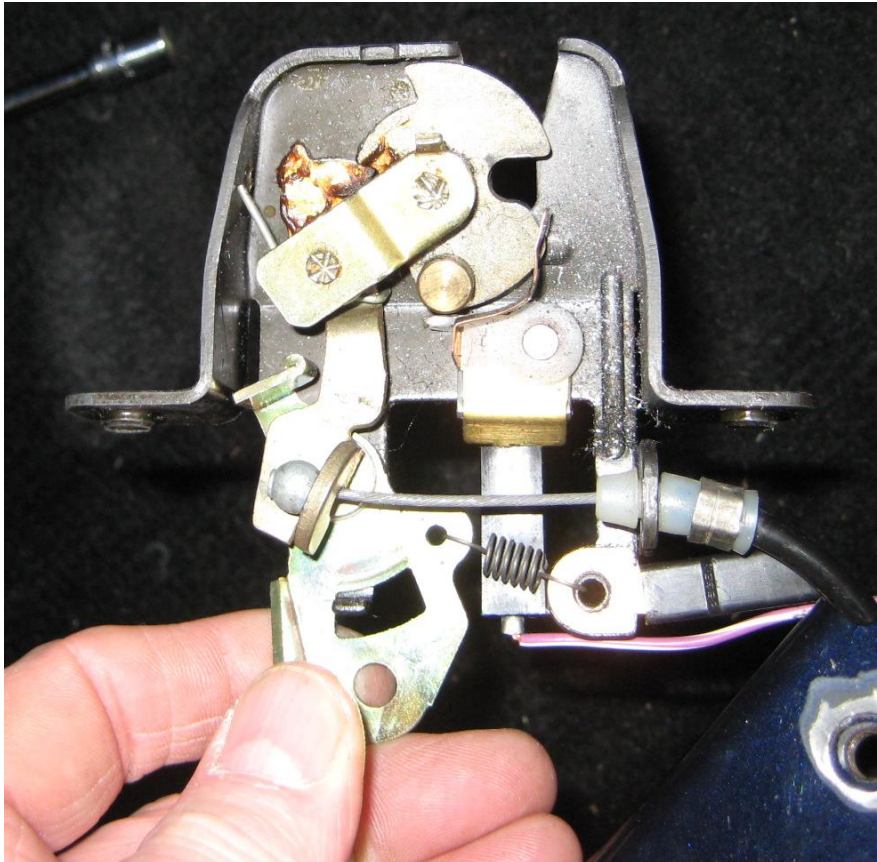


RV8 boot lid lock and boot light switch



Godfrey Dennis has some useful pictures of the lock on the boot lid on his RV8 which he feels "should help to clarify the metal tab which acts as the switch mechanism for the interior boot lamp, particularly No. 013 (**top right** and enlarged to the right) which shows the position when the boot lid is open, and No. 014 (**top left** and enlarged to the left) the position when the boot lid is closed.

You can see a small round spindle in both pictures, and indeed in all of the set, but looking at Nos. 13 and 14 you can see in No 13 (right) where the metal tab contacts the spindle when the boot is open to complete the circuit and put the **light on** and in 14 (left) where it separates from the spindle, when the lid is closed, to break the circuit and keep the **light off.**"
