

Jeff Shaw successfully bid for the very low mileage RV8 in Le Mans Green at the H&H auction at Duxford in March 2020 and says the clutch packed up there so the car could not be driven from Duxford and was brought home on a truck. Jeff says it needs a thorough recommission and a number of small dings on the bodywork repaired. The widow who sold the car had it stored for many years. As Jeff works his way through the maintenance items he has a report which acts as a reminder for fellow RV8 owners of the **need to change their fuel filters regularly**. Above is the filter he removed from the RV8 with only 4,600 miles on the clock – clearly the filter is in a grim state! Jeff says "just because it is a low mileage car don't think that the filter does not need changing". He thinks he may have to drop the tank and flush it through.
