Peter Beadle, formerly with Moss Europe and before with University Motors at Epsom, says AHH6946 was the original factory part number for the Chrome Boot Rack and both Moss Europe and Brown & Gammons offer a Stainless Steel version of this item – part numbers: Moss GAC4003SS and B&G AHH 6946SS. The later US Dealer post 1970 option was made by AMCO and was fitted to all the US Black MGB LE Roadsters. It is now available in stainless steel from Moss, their part number is GAC4003B.
