

RV8 badges – John Bolt



This badge is in stainless steel with black etching and has double sided sticky tape on the back to fix it to the car. John has yet to remove the protective paper over the sticky surface and fix it to his car, so he has simply set it on the boot of his car for this photo to show how it would look. It was made for him by a friend.



This is the badge which is fixed to the boot lid of John Bolt's RV8 at present. The "R" and "V" are from the Rover script that John removed from the wings of his RV8 and the "8" is from the badge for a Rover 800 car.



Here both badges are shown on the boot lid of John Bolt's RV8 to compare both styles. The "RV8" badge certainly looks good and it has some of the style of the original "V8" logo used for the Factory MGBGT V8 model back in the 1970s.
