### Fuel duty increase from 2010 to be staged

**1.28** To drive transition to a low-carbon and resource-efficient economy, while also contributing to the Government's plans for fiscal consolidation, Budget 2010 announces:

• that, to ease pressure on business and household incomes at a time when other prices are rising, the main fuel duty increase for 2010 will be staged, with an increase of one penny per litre on 1 April and one penny per litre on 1 October 2010, then 0.76 pence per litre on 1 January 2011. Fuel duty will also rise by one penny per litre in real terms on 1 April each year from 2011 to 2014; and

### New first year rates of vehicle excise duty for new cars

Vehicle excise 7.40

From 1 April 2010, the Government will introduce new first-year rates of vehicle duty excise duty (VED), as announced at Budget 2008. Under this system, all cars emitting up to 130 grams of carbon dioxide per kilometre (g CO, per km) will pay no VED in the first year. Cars emitting over 165 g CO, per km will pay additional VED in the first year - up to £950 for cars emitting over 255 g CO2 per km. First-year rates will encourage the purchase of more fuel-efficient cars by providing a strong signal to the consumer at the point of purchase.
