Finding the north eastern car park at the Goodwood Revival



Directions to the north east car park coming from the north

Turn off south from Milford on the A3 and go through Haslemere and Midhurst on the A286. Then as you come down the hill into Singleton the road turns sharp right in the village to go on towards Chichester. Going on from Singleton you soon reach a turning to the left which is the road that goes up over the Downs by the Racecourse and then down to the Goodwood Circuit and Airfield. Although that is the natural route to Goodwood, when the Goodwood Revival is on it is difficult to get to the north east car park I have marked below. So what you need to do is turn left in the middle of Singleton and go east to the village of East Dean (green route) where you turn right (south) so you can drive down a pleasant B road through the trees to a crossroads just east of the car park. There you turn right (west) on to a road which is one-way west during the Goodwood Revival and after just a hundred yards or so there is an opening to a large grassed field which is the car park.

As you can see from the map above, you can also come in from a turning off the A285 which is the road via Petworth (red route).
