

How do I find the V8 Register at Silverstone?

Once you pass the ticket control point at the main entrance to Silverstone Circuit, just drive straight ahead which will take you over a steel bridge which crosses the Grand Prix track at Bridge Corner just before the Complex (the series of corners - Priory, Brooklands & Luffield - leading to Woodcote Corner and the Main Straight). Once over that bridge some 150 yards ahead you will see a small roundabout. At the roundabout take the second exit at 11 o'clock where you will meet some marshals. Their task is to direct **only** MGs on into the centre of the Circuit and all non-MGs are directed off to the right into the general car parking area. If you are in an MG you will be waived through and ahead of you some 100 yards or so you will see a **second bridge**.

Approaching the second bridge

At this point you will be by the red arrowhead in the plan above. The bridge takes you over the Club Straight (the wide grey track on the plan above) and then as you come down the slope from the bridge you will see the V8 Marquee (a large white marquee) and a grass area on the left. That area is marked with a blue arrow and "V8 parking area" on the plan above. This area is the dedicated MGV8 parking area for the weekend. You can leave your car here with some confidence that it is parked amongst vehicles admired by fellow V8 enthusiasts - we usually have over 150 V8s parked there each day.
