

MGBGTV8 overall: UK 79% and Overseas 21%.


MGBGTV8s Overseas




A greater proportion of Factory V8s are registered in the UK (79%) than RV8s (66%) but overseas registrations are more widely spread than those of RV8s. In mainland Europe registrations of Factory V8s have increased over the last 18 months as many enthusiasts in the Eurozone with a strong Euro have seen MGBGTV8s advertised in the UK as exceptional value. In Germany the "historic" status for road tax allocated to MGBGTV8s in recent years has stimulated many purchases by German enthusiasts.

RV8 registrations in the UK are slightly higher (in percentage terms) in the south and East Anglia compared with those for MGBGTV8s.



Some 70% of RV8 overseas registrations are downunder - 64% in Australia and 6% in New Zealand. Australia has by far the largest number of RV8s registered overseas with over 200 RV8s registered there, very nearly all imported from Japan with airconditioning seen as an attractive feature for many Australia enthusiasts.

Overall registrations of all MGV8s – total is 3,240 including 1,639 MGBGTV8s, 55 Costello V8s, and 945 RV8s, 175 MGBGTV8 Conversions, 348 V8 Roadsters and 74 MGZT260V8s. We also have a few MGSVs too.
