

FilterMag magnetic oil filter wraps

Even with an oil filter there will be abrasive particles circulating in the engine lubrication system producing engine wear. FilterMag is a patented design – a semicircular heat resistant wrap which clips very firmly to a standard oil filter and its powerful magnets hold the superfine particles on the inside surface of the oil filter. It can be reused again and again - when a routine oil change comes up the wrap can be removed, the old filter with the super fine sludge of particles on the inside is removed and binned and then a new filter is fixed and the wrap rerplaced. The standard FilterMag is for oil filters 3.50" to 3.90" diameter and 2.5" high. See the FilterMag website and a useful YouTube video

Removing fine particles keeps your oil cleaner and helps to reduce engine wear and increasing the life of your engine

FilterMag say "moving parts operating inside an engine wear and create metallic particles that end up in the circulating oil. Normal oil filters catch particles larger than 25 micron. However, smaller particles pass through the filter and continue to circulate in the oil. These particles are small enough to fit between bearing surfaces to continue the wear cycle. FilterMag's extremely powerful magnets trap these wear-causing particles on the inside wall of the filter canister removing them from the lubricating oil. Removing these particles keeps your oil cleaner and helps to break the wear cycle, increasing the life of your engine."

Fellow MGBGTV8 member **Victor Todman** says FilterMag wrap is sold in the UK by SC Parts. (part number No 481134 for the V8) and cost £37.82 in 2013. He adds "it is fixed to the filter and is effective at keeping the oil clean. Before using it, the engine oil in my V8 was always black when drained for the 3,000 mile change, now it is only slightly discoloured. SC Parts sell a tool for cutting up the used oil filter to see how much metal had been trapped, but I'm not ready to find out just yet! They also list magnetic plates (part numbers 481145 and 258526) for attaching to the sump, but obviously these give no chance of seeing metal particles, nor removing them unless the sump is dropped."
