
## MGBGTV8 gearbox compared with an MGB gearbox




## How can you tell a V8 gearbox from an MGB unit?

The information you need is on pages 108-A13 and A15 of the MGB/V8 Parts Manual AKD0039. It is also on page 5 of the Moss MGBGTV8 Parts Supplement - a copy of this is on the V8 website, just check out the "V8 Support and Information" rollover button on the LHS on the V8 Website homepage.

The gearbox number on an MGBGTV8 unit is stamped on the top of the gearbox casing (see arrow, left) whereas the number on an MGB gearbox is stamped on the top of the gearbox casing adjacent to the dipstick.

## Do how can you spot the difference?

The V8 gearbox (above left) does not have a dipstick on the side (see the MGB unit alongside which does have the dipstick). The V8 gearbox simply has a plug on the side which serves as a gearbox oil level test and filler.
