Rebuilding an MGBGTV8 – Damask 0450 (Part 7 of a series of reports)





The driver's inner step sill was holed in two places, so it needed replacing. There is a repair section available that is 4 feet long and avoids the need to remove the rearmost part. However, this does require a butt weld, which would create a weak point. In order to overcome this, a strengthening plate has been welded over the join. This completes the preparation of the driver's side, prior to sand blasting.

Next, we shall turn our attention to the passenger's side.
