

## How does the Online V8 Shop system work?

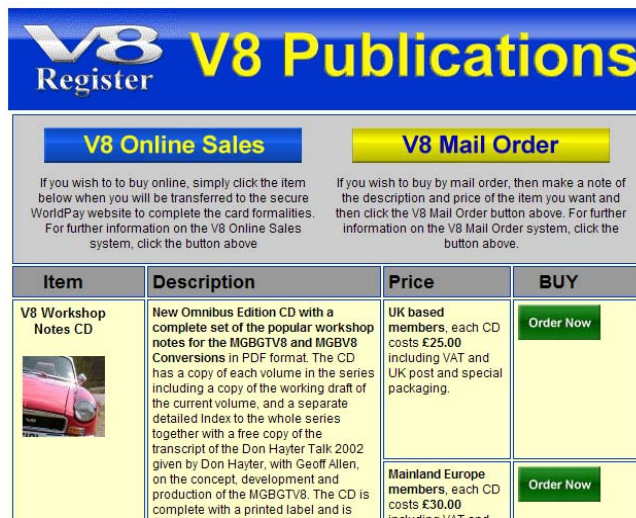
Assuming you wish to buy a copy of the V8NOTES CD using the Online V8 Shop



**Step1:** click the **V8 Shop** rollover button in the grey band below the scrolling banner on the homepage of the V8 website.



**Step 2:** click the **V8 Publications** button.



**Step 3:** click the **Order Now** button. This stage is so Club members can select the member only rate by noting their current Club membership number on their order. If you are not a Club member then select the non member option and click **Buy This**. You will go to Step 5.

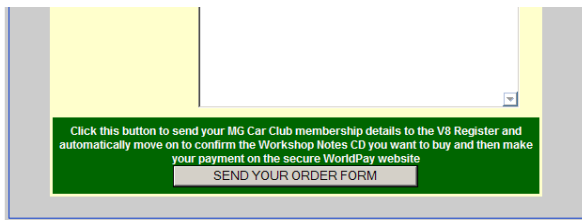

**Step 4:** complete your order form. If you are ordering V8 Regalia items you provide your size, colour and logo requirements for the item here.

You are then transferred to the webpage where you buy the item.

**Step 5:** click the **Buy This** button for the item you wish to purchase using the online payment system.

**Please note:** you then leave the V8 website and are transferred to the **secure WorldPay website** where your card details are processed and a payment is made.



**Step 6:** follow the WorldPay process by providing your card details and completing the payment.

**Step 7:** Following the completion of your purchase on the WorldPay website you will receive a confirmation by email of your purchase with a reference number for any queries you may subsequently have.

**Step 8:** an email is also sent by WorldPay to the V8 Register with details of the online purchase with a confirmation that a payment has been made.

**Step 9:** You will receive an acknowledgement from the V8 Register of the receipt of that WorldPay confirmation with an indication that the goods will be sent to you shortly.

**Step 10:** when the workshop notes CD is made and mailed to you, the V8 Registrar will send you an email advice as follows:

I have made your CD and am mailing it to you today.  
Please confirm safe receipt in due course.

Workshop notes CDs are sent by First Class “Large Letter” rate in the UK, by Airmail “Small Packet” rate to mainland Europe and by Airmail “Small Packet” rate to any other overseas destination.

**Step 11:** following safe receipt of the goods, the buyer usually sends an email to the V8 Registrar confirming safe receipt.

This system has been set up on the V8 website as a low cost online sales system. There are no shopping basket facilities so if you wish to buy more than one item you will need to make a separate online purchase using the Online V8 Shop system. Well over 95% of sales are for individual items so the lack of the shopping cart is not at present a major difficulty. In some cases the V8 Shop is set up so you can purchase two items – for example two Hi-Vis Vests as a special offer. In over four years of operating the Online V8 Shop we have only had two complaints from members that they were unable to make a purchase using the system.

If any member has the technical skills to establish a more effective Online V8 Shop system that can be easily integrated with the V8 website and is simple to operate and maintain, please do get in touch.
