Body shell (MGBGTV8)

I purchased an MGBGTV8 body shell for £2,650 (£2,150 paid by Paypal - Andrew my son actually did the purchase) with £500 still to be paid on collection. The registration number **3513 MG**. The owner had taken out the engine, gearbox, axle and front cross member and had removed front wings and bonnet. Had purchased all the panels for a rebuild but then he had everything stolen from his garage, just leaving the shell. He also has all the parts they did not take. He is open to offers for these items, they are not included in the offer.

£2,650 - for the body shell

Donor car (MGBGT)

I purchased an MGBGT (registration number **UPP 124R**) to be a donor car for the V8 shell, from Beech Hill Garage, as a barn find at £750. It has front arch liners and underneath, it appears to have all new shocks and king pins. The donor shell is suffering from sitting with no road use. Holes where water has sat. I have removed and stripped both doors, only five screws/nuts did not undo over the two doors. I removed wing screws on top and all but one came out. The only areas where rust has taken place is where water has sat, like right in the middle of one of the wings, not where you expect it. I think the car was rebuilt, painted, undersealed, with new chrome wheel trims and then parked up. Both doors, tailgate and wings will go again. Bonnet scrapped. All glass is perfect. Tailgate is good. The inside is perfect just needing cleaning. Power washed car when I got it and not a drip went inside. I have both sets of keys. Connected battery, fuel pump started up and all electrics work, connected with new fuel and engine started and runs with excellent oil pressure.
