
# MG Race Day at Castle Combe Circuit – Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2007

### Dedicated car park for MG Car Club members

The dedicated Club parking area will be on the west side of the Circuit between Bobbies Chicane and Camp Corner. Entry will be through the **Main Entrance 4** which you can see on the copy of the Circuit layout reproduced below. This is a convenient place to park as it is a relatively short walk to the Paddock area where you can see the race cars being prepared, the assembly area for cars waiting to go out for the next event and the welcoming tea room run by local ladies who bake their own cakes and provide excellent tea! A useful concession was mentioned in news item on page 10 of the August 2007 issue of Safety Fast! - "we hope to arrange free Paddock passes for those who attend" and park up in the Club area. So another good reason to make for the **Main Entrance 4** where you will be able to park up with fellow V8 and Club members.



### Reminder on selecting an entrance to the Circuit

Normally members coming from the west via M4 J18 or the east via M4 J17 or the old A4 might park up using the **Public Entrance 2** (just east of the Paddock) or **Public Entrance 1** (at Quarry corner) but on this occasion it will be worth making for the **Main Entrance 4** instead.

**Tickets** will be available on the day at the public entrances to the Circuit.

### Memorable MG Route - Newbury to Castle Combe

The first Memorable MG Route in the series is from Newbury to Castle Combe along the old A4 through Marlborough, Calne and Chippenham. For sheer driving pleasure the A4, at times of relatively light traffic, takes a great deal of beating. In many places the road is open with long sweeping bends and occasionally you can still see the characteristic "three lane" feature so familiar from an earlier motoring age. There are many places of interest along the route from country houses and estates to ancient stone circles and mounds together with some enticing refreshment stops.
