Mike Macartney - Building a V8
Roadster. First up was Mike Macartney,
well known to members for his excellent
series of articles posted on the V8 website
who talked through his previous restoration
of an covering his current restoration project

of a V8 Roadster. However at the seminar he focused on an MGBGTV8 including his planning, budgeting and management of the rebuild, as well as more detailed stories of the challenges involved! The car's owner, Dougald MacNeill, a longstanding V8 member was present with the car and members were able to examine it and see the quality of Mike's work.

Mark Wanstall - Hoyle Suspension upgrades. Next up was Mark Wanstall a long term MGV8 enthusiast who runs a very successful specialist servicing and restoration business, Fisher Services. In 2014 he bought John Hoyle's engineering business supplying high quality independent rear suspension, front suspension and brake upgrades for MGs. Mark brought along examples of the Hoyle upgrades and one of his customers, Richard Martin, brought along his V8 Roadster which has all the Hoyle parts fitted, so members were able to examine it in detail.

Nic Houslip – update on V8 cooling issues. Nic Houslip finished off the morning with a short update on cooling issues for V8s, always a hot topic! It prompted a varied discussion of members' own cooling problems.
