Two days after these famous gates at the MG Plant in Abingdon closed for the final time on Friday 24th October 1980, John Dupont and his father parked up by Gate 3 on Sunday with their then new MGB Roadster alongside John's MGBGTV8 (Teal Blue 0534) was purchased new from University Motors in Hanwell west London. The Factory records show the V8 went through Paint Finishing at the MG Plant on the day the model was launched at the Motor Show at Earl's Court in August 1973. His V8 was later sold and has been owned for many years by an enthusiast in Germany.
