MOT exemption from May

The MOT exemption changes

will become available from 20th May 2018. We have clear information for MGV8 enthusiasts on the MOT exemption available for a car manufactured or registered for the first time at least 40 years previously, of a type no longer in production, has been historically preserved or maintained in its original state and has not undergone substantial changes in the technical characteristics of its main components in the last 30 years.
