## Fuel duty freeze

In October the Prime Minister confirmed the pledge to freeze fuel duty by ruling out any increase in fuel duty in the Budget later in the month. There had been speculation that the annual fuel duty freeze, in place since 2010, might have come to an end, with an inflation-linked rise used to pay for the £20bn in extra annual funding promised for the NHS. The continuation of the freeze was the ninth year in a row. Average petrol prices have gone up by 11.5p a litre in the last year, with diesel rising by 14p a litre. The continuation of the freeze is very welcome news for motorists at a time when crude oil prices have continued rising, putting pressure on pump prices.
