Auction report – MGBGTV8 listed at Richard Edmonds auction at Chippenham in July 2018









Our Pricewatch volunteer, Andy Goves, went to see the **Factory MGBGTV8** listed for auction at the recent Richard Edmonds auction at Chippenham. The auction of 2,019 lots of 'ephemera, spares, mascots and badges; petroliana; motorcycles, motor cars and commercial vehicles' was held over four days (including viewing) in several large marquees on a farm field with very good access off the A350 and adjacent to a well-known farm shop, complete with catering and toilet facilities on site. It is an established auction company specialising in the world of vintage and classic cars and motorcycles. My impression is one of a very knowledgeable and friendly auction house that I would enjoy buying a car from. I've simply never been there before as they have not had anything on sale to tempt me! The car listed for auction was a chrome bumper conversion, originally a Factory rubber bumper MGBGTV8 (Flamenco Red 2426) built in April 1975, despatched to Charles Clarke in Wolverhampton and first registered in September 1975. **Update, car was not sold**.
